Subject-related competencies (FK)

Graduates of the master's program in International Business Consulting

FK1 ... demonstrate knowledge and understanding of legal and/or economic topics

FK2 ... demonstrate knowledge and understanding of business administration and related topics and, on this basis, possess the ability to solve problems independently and in a problem-solving oriented manner.

SK3 ... demonstrate knowledge and understanding in business administration and related subject areas and, on this basis, have the ability to solve problems characterized by incomplete information by developing their own ideas and concepts.

Interdisciplinary competencies (ÜK):

Graduates of the Master's program in International Business Consulting

ÜK1 ... have a sound knowledge of business management and related topics and have the ability to apply this knowledge in new and unfamiliar, multi-layered and contradictory situations that are complex and/or interdisciplinary in nature

ÜK2 ... have a methodical repertoire in order to constructively, purposefully and motivationally work in a team or self-directed projects or project tasks (considering social, scientific and ethical findings)

ÜK3 ... have knowledge of organizational and behavioral psychological (sub-)topics and are able to find solutions to tasks using this knowledge.

ÜK4 ... have the ability to prepare written work (project work such as the thesis) taking into account scientific criteria and to defend their points of view.
